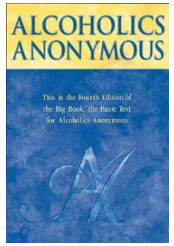

Saturday: (Centered around Group-Area – Coffee throughout the day!)

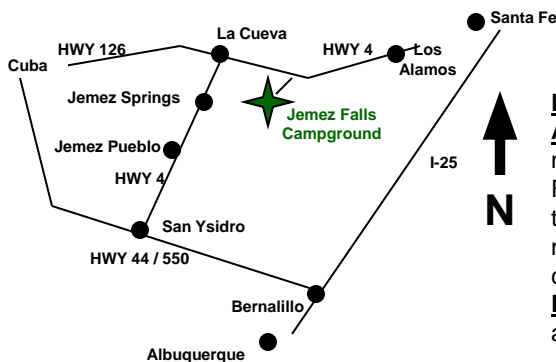
8:00'ish AM – 10 AM - Breakfast Potluck Picnic – Area 46, District 11 El Centro Group Sponsoring the main courses

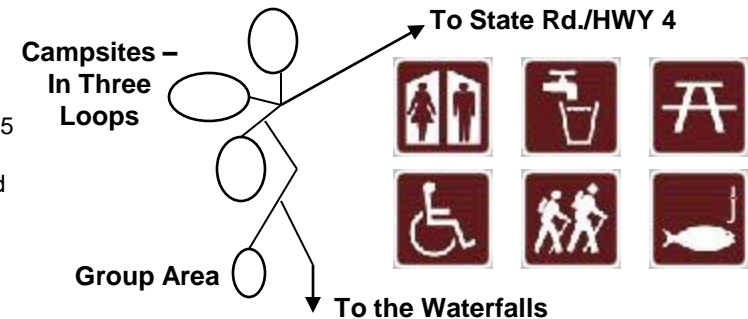
12 PM – 2 PM – District 11 Sponsored Potluck Picnic – District 11 providing plenty of meats and buns at the potluck!

Location: Six miles east of La Cueva on State Road 4
Access: From the Jemez Ranger Station near Jemez Springs, go 7.5 miles north to the junction of State Roads 4 and 126 at La Cueva. Follow State Road 4 approximately six miles east to the campground turnoff on your right. From the turn-off continue approximately 1 1/4 miles to Jemez Falls Group Area which is south of the family campground / campsites.
Facilities: Non-Flush Toilets, Potable Water Faucets at Campsites and Group Area, Some Group Wheel-chair Access, Picnic Tables



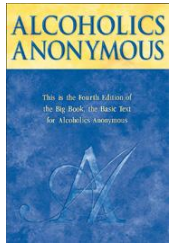

Spread the Word – Coordinate the active spreading of the word about this event to ALL District 11 groups and surrounding Districts from now until August 7th.

Friday Campsite and Campfire Meeting Coordination – Help others know where Campfire Meeting and Main Camp are; assist with campsite info.: on-site-only site rentals/registration and fellowship activities available (trails, falls location, hot-springs location, etc.); Chair Campfire Meeting at Dusk (Julian and Phil O. to assist)

Saturday Breakfast Cooking – Provide and cook the main courses for the Breakfast Potluck **TAKEN – District 11, El Centro Group!**

Saturday Breakfast Potluck Setup & Coordination – District 11 Supplying Paper Goods, Eating utensils, etc. You setup and coordinate the Breakfast Potluck.

Saturday Coffee – District 11 Supplying the coffee supplies – Coordinate and make the coffee Saturday during all events – need to coordinate how to make the coffee – gas stoves, generator, etc.

Saturday Games – Coordinate and set-up the games for the Saturday Group Area between the time of the Breakfast and the Closing Meeting; Volleyball, Horse-shoes, kids games, etc. – Phil O. can help with some supplies.

Saturday Noon Potluck Chefs – District 11 providing PLENTY of charcoal, foil, meats and buns. You set up and cook it on-time, safe, edible and tasty too! You also keep the meats cool Saturday until the cooking – Phil O. to do that through Friday & will supply ice & coolers to assist. **TAKEN – District 11, Serenity Group!**

Saturday Noon Potluck Setup & Coordination – District 11 providing the paper goods and eating utensils, etc. You coordinate and set up the potluck on-time, and keep all of the foodstuffs safe (i.e. – cool, covered as needed and in the shade)

Saturday AA Open, BB Topic Meeting Chair – Chair the meeting bringing all meeting supplies. Format: open with Serenity Prayer, thank Participants, reading of Preamble, reading of How it Works, reading of Traditions Short Form, topic out of reading from main text of Big Book, 7th Tradition passed, open sharing, close meeting on-time with Third-Step Prayer – ad lib within the Traditions within this Format as you see fit. Meeting starts at 2PM sharp and ends at 3PM sharp.

Saturday Closing – Looking for 2 Groups on this one! – Close the campground with Phil O.– Break-down and re-pack all District supplies; package up and dispose of all trash – on-site bins usually fill-up so carrying bins to next site 200 yds. away is generally needed. Need to be all done and gone by 4PM! **1st Spot TAKEN – District 11, Singleness of Purpose Group; 2nd Spot open!**
