Phone calls down, walk-ins up, web visits increased. Subs needed to cover for deskworkers who are absent. Most urgent need is for evening subs, weekdays and weekends. Evening shifts are 7-10 on weekdays and 6-9 on the weekend.

Two shifts need to be filled every other Sunday 9-12 and every other Sunday 3-6. One night phone went uncovered due to an emergency. 45 out 177 shifts were covered by subs. 15 of these shifts were covered by non-volunteers.

Issue of other disabled may want to access funds. The money has been used exclusively for deaf interpreters up until now. Mention of language barrier vs. disability.
